



The Philly Big 5 is a \$.50 wager that is divided into a **Pool A** and a **Pool B** (carryover) pool. The entire net Philly Big 5 pool and carryover, if any, shall be distributed to the holder of a single winning ticket selecting the first place finisher in each of the selected five (5) contests, based upon the official order of finish. If there is no single winning ticket selecting the first place finisher of all five (5) contests, the **Pool A** of the net Philly Big 5 shall be distributed as a single price pool to those who selected the first place finisher in the greatest number of Philly Big 5 contests, and the **Pool B** shall be added to the carryover.

“Single winning ticket”, as used in this subsection, shall be defined as having occurred when there is one and only one winning ticket that correctly selected the first place finisher in each of the Philly Big 5 contests, based upon the official order of finish, to be verified by the unique serial number assigned by the tote company that issued the winning ticket. In the event that there is more than one winning ticket that correctly selected the first place finisher in each of the Philly Big 5 contests, based upon the official order of finish, the *“single winning ticket”* shall be deemed to **not** have occurred.

Should a betting interest in any of the Philly Big 5 contests be scratched, excused or determined to be a non-starter, the actual favorite, as evidenced by total amounts wagered in the win pool for the contest at the close of wagering on that contest, shall be substituted for the scratched betting interest for all purposes, including pool calculations. In the event that the win pool total for two or more favorites is identical, the substitute selection shall be the betting interest with the

lowest program number. If wagers on a scratched horse(s) transferred to the post time favorite creates two or more winning combinations on a single ticket, as audited by the totalizator service provider of the host association, the ticket shall be deemed a single winner. If there are no other winning tickets in the pool, as audited by the totalizator, the ticket shall be deemed a “**single winning ticket**” and the holder of the ticket shall be entitled to the entire net pool, including the **Pool B** (carryover) pool. This same rule will apply if there is a “**dead heat**” and there is only one “**single winning ticket**” (even if it contains all dead heat winners). The totalizator shall produce reports showing each of the wagering combinations with substituted betting interests which became winners as a result of the substitution, in addition to the normal winning combination.

Change of surface from turf to dirt has no effect on the Philly Big 5.

If at least three of the contests in the Philly Big 5 are cancelled or declared a “no contest”, the pool will be cancelled and all Philly Big 5 wagers for that performance will be refunded. If one or two contests of the Philly Big 5 are cancelled or declared a “no contest”, the net pool shall be distributed as a single price pool to those whose selections finished first in the greatest number of Philly Big 5 contests for that performance. Such distribution shall include the portion ordinarily retained for the Philly Big 5 carryover but not the carryover from previous performances.

The Philly Big 5 carryover may be **capped** at a designated amount approve by the PSHRC so that if, at the close of any performance, the amount in the Philly Big 5 carryover equals or exceeds the designated cap, the Philly Big 5 carryover will be frozen until it is won or distributed under other provisions of this rule. After the Philly Big 5 carryover is frozen, one hundred percent of the net pool, part of which ordinarily would be added to the Philly Big 5 carryover, shall be distributed to those whose selections finished first in the greatest number of Philly Big 5 contests for that performance.

Mandatory Distribution – An association may distribute a Philly Big 5, that includes a carryover, on a specified race date at their sole discretion, but must provide notice to the PSHRC and the betting public at least two weeks prior to the date of the distribution.

Should the Philly Big 5 carryover be designated for distribution on a specified date and performance in which there are no wagers selecting the first place finisher in each of the Philly Big 5 contests, the entire pool shall be distributed as a single price pool to those whose selections finished first in the greatest number of Philly Big 5 contests.

Pool Division – The **takeout** for the Philly Big 5 shall be **15%**. The net pool shall be divided **70% to Pool A** and **30% to Pool B (carryover)**
