The Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association (PHBA) administers the Pennsylvania Breeding Fund which is funded by a share of pari-mutuel and slot terminal revenue.

The Pennsylvania Breeding Program distributes more money, on a per foal basis, than nearly every other state-bred program.

Incentives are earned by Pennsylvania-Bred horses which finish first through third in any race contested in the state.

In 2012, the Breeding Fund distributed over \$30 million in Awards, "Owner Bonuses" and Purses.

\$10.1 million in Breeder and Stallion Awards

\$6.8 million in "Owner Bonuses" at PARX, Penn National and Presque Isle Downs (bonus of up to 40% of the purse earned on overnight races - paid with the purse for first through third)

\$1.6 million in purses for Pennsylvania-Bred Stakes representing 22 races

In addition, the Breeding Fund and the Pennsylvania Horsemen (HBPA and PTHA) paid \$11.5 million in purses for Pennsylvania-Bred restricted races

The Smarty Jones Stakes (GIII) - \$350,000

This race was first run in 2010 as a prep for the \$1,000,000 PA Derby and named after PA's hometown hero, Smarty Jones. The Smarty Jones gained graded stakes status in 2012.

The Turf Monster Handicap (GIII) - \$350,000

While the name may seem unusual, the Turf Monster Handicap was established in 2002 with the idea of creating a race that could produce a large, competitive field for a specialized type of racehorse, the turf sprinter. Carrying a purse of \$350,000, and open to 3 year olds and up, the Turf Monster achieved its goal right from the outset. The Turf Monster is now a grade 3, event thanks to Chamberlain Bridge's victory in the 2010 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint.

The Greenwood Cup (GIII) - \$200,000

This race was first known as the Greenwood Cup Handicap run at 1 & 1/2 miles on the turf. Not run in 2005, 2006 & 2007. In 2008, the race returned, coming off the turf and run under stakes conditions. The Greenwood Cup remained a 1 & 1/2 mile event gaining grade 3 status in 2012.
